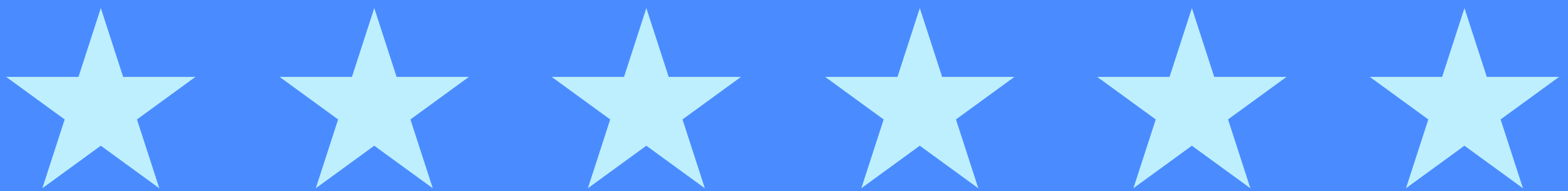

MAY 5TH IS RED DRESS DAY

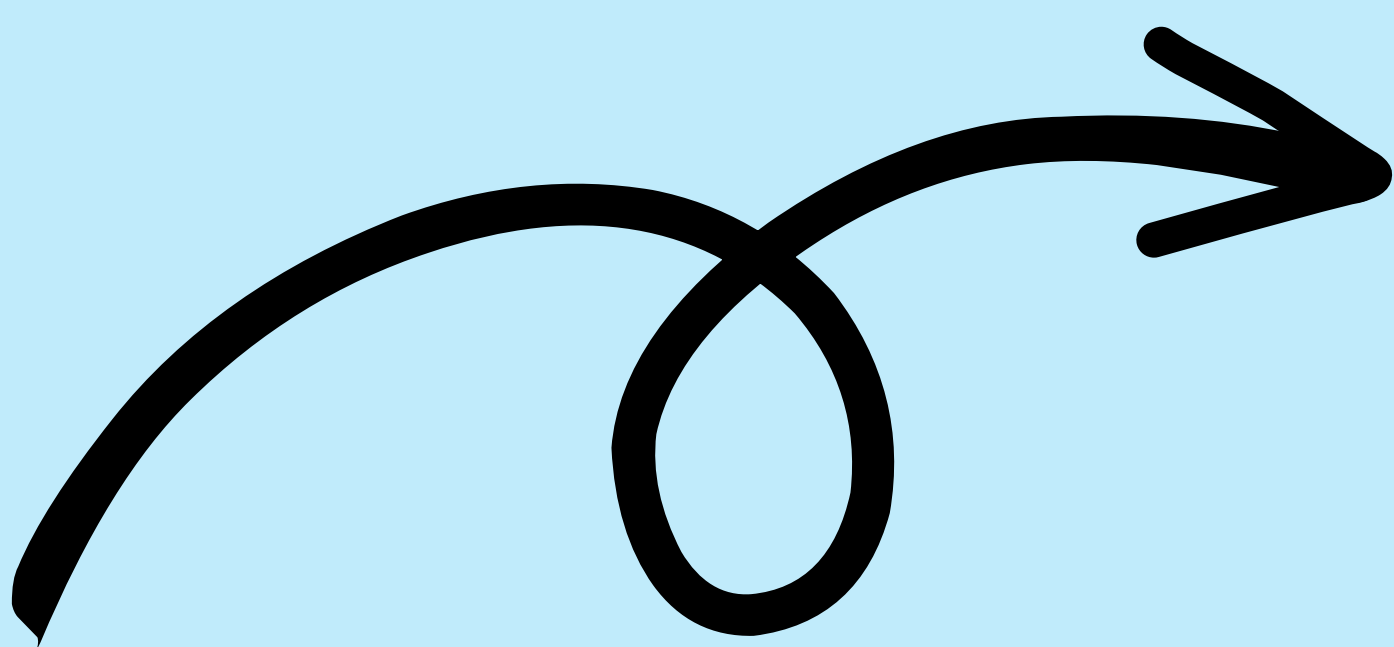

THIS ALLOWS US TO COMPARE ALL OF THE ITEMS ON OUR LIBRARY SHELVES, WITH THE COMPUTER SYSTEM, TO IDENTIFY LOST, DAMAGED OR OBSOLETE BOOK. IT'S BEEN 5 YEARS SINCE OUR LAST INVENTORY, SO IT'S ABOUT TIME WE CONDUCT ANOTHER ONE!

SHORTLY THEREAFTER, I WILL BE UNDERTAKING ANOTHER HUGE PROJECT WITH OUR FICTION SECTION (CHAPTER BOOKS!), CALLED GENREFICATION. GENREFYING A COLLECTION IS DESIGNED WITH THE INTENT OF HELPING STUDENTS FIND BOOKS OF INTEREST WITH EASE. SIMPLY, I WILL BE REARRANGING THE FICTION SECTION BY CATEGORY, SUBJECT OR GENRE. WHILE IT'S A HEFTY PROJECT, GENREFICATION HAS BECOME A HOT TOPIC IN THE LIBRARY WORLD, AND I TRULY FEEL IT WILL ENHANCE THE SEARCHING PROCESS FOR OUR STUDENTS.

COME THE END OF MAY (OR EVEN SOONER!), I ASK THAT YOU PLEASE HELP ENCOURAGE YOUR CHILDREN TO RETURN THEIR LIBRARY BOOKS IN A TIMELY MANNER, AS IT'S IMPERATIVE THAT I HAVE ALL OF THE LIBRARY BOOKS BACK IN THE LIBRARY BEFORE I START DOING INVENTORY.
