




## **PIZZA WEDNESDAYS & HOT LUNCH!!!**

It is recommended you sign up to receive a reminder email the day before hot lunch is delivered.



The Hot Lunch days are as follows:

**EVERY WEDNESDAY: Pizza Hut** 

May 10: Sushi Lovers (due May 2) June 14: Dairy Queen (due June 6)

For Pizza Wednesdays: Order must <u>be placed and paid in full</u> the Sunday before that Wednesday. For Hot Lunches: Orders must <u>be placed and paid in full 8 days</u> prior to the scheduled lunch date as per our vendor requirements. Unpaid orders will be canceled.**Make sure you follow the order all the way to the end to pay!** Munchalunch automatically cancels an order that hasn't been paid within 1 hour.

- Munchalunch charges us a per transaction fee, so if you are able to order and pay for multiple lunches in one transaction you will be saving the PAC transaction fees.
- If your child is absent on the lunch date, you are welcome to come and pick up the order by noon, but the food cannot be kept for the following day.
- Consistent with previous years, there are **NO REFUNDS**.
