1) Spirit Club and Early Act Student Service Club – Next week we will be starting two clubs at Byng. These clubs are open to Intermediate students who would like to help out in one of two areas. Spirit Club will focus on organizing and advertising school spirit days at Byng. EarlyAct™ is a Rotary International youth program, sponsored by the Rotary Club of Steveston. It is a self-supporting, school-wide service club in which all students are members. Its main mission is to carry out at least three service projects annually—one each for the school and the local community, and one that furthers international understanding. EarlyAct builds leadership skills and helps children understand that they can make a positive difference.
