### **Lockdown Drill**

On **Monday, Feb 7 at 9 am**, Byng School will conduct a Lockdown Drill with the support from our liaison RCMP officer.

These procedures have been developed with the support of law enforcement agencies and are consistent through all metro school districts. A Lock Down Drill will secure the school building and safely shelter all students, staff and visitors inside the building. The purpose of this drill is to keep the students safe from any danger, such as an intruder, inside the school building. During the drill, all of the perimeter doors to the school building will be locked and will remain locked until the danger or issue inside the building is removed. To enable everyone to remain safe, no one will be allowed to enter the building or leave the building until the authorities authorize such a release.






#### Did you know......
