## 4. Chair's Report - Jennie Middleton

- Welcome to all returning and new families
- Jennie explained what the PAC's purposes are: provide a bridge between the school and parents, build community within the school family, support various activities at the school. Fundraising should always have a purpose, ie. building community, specific projects that enhance the entire school community, etc.
- PAC is for the entire student body. We cannot speak on behalf of a specific individual. We can make recommendations on where to go for more support and information but that's it.
- We have a number of positions where the coordinator will be leaving the school soon as their youngest child moves on to highschool. We will need to think about succession planning this year.

- 5. Principal/Vice Principal Report Lesa Schultz/Eleanor Lee
  - 1. Terry Fox September 27<sup>th</sup> we would love some parent volunteers to help that afternoon in the neighbourhood.
  - 2. Thank you for the contribution to our camp this year. Grade 6 and 7 students will be going to Lake Sasamat for a one-day camp.
  - 3. Early Dismissal Days on October 4<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> for Parent-Teacher Conferences online or in-person. More information to come from your child's teacher.
  - 4. Reporting Guidelines We are still using the e-portfolios to report on the core competencies and as a window to learning. There will be a learning summary before the Winter Break, another one before Spring Break and a final year-end report in June.
  - 5. Wish List Does the PAC want the teachers/school to make a wish list? The PAC doesn't have enough funds at the moment to be able to purchase items off a wish list due to the lack of ability to fundraise over the last couple of years so we will wait on that.
  - 6. Staffing we are still looking to hire a few teachers at Byng but we did hire a 2/3 teacher and a 6/7 teacher today!
  - 7. Jordan Hanson will be coming to Byng to do a drumming workshop as part of our Artists in Residence series from November 28-December 2<sup>nd</sup>. Each class will have two sessions and then there will be a final performance on December 2<sup>nd</sup>.
  - 8. Byng Wear we will be offering this to families soon and then we'd love some help from the parent community to sort and deliver the clothing to the classes one afternoon/week.

# Questions:

1. There is a new band teacher this year. Will they be using the ukuleles? Our band teacher will only be teaching band this year as they will be at 2-3 schools and only working with the older students for band class. Other classroom teachers are welcome to use them in their classes.

# 6. Treasurer's Report - Maureen Gardner

We have applied for the gaming grant and are waiting to hear back about that. There are some rules that apply to spending of the gaming grant funds.

Two items on our budget: Japanese Garden Refurbishment The Garden Boxes

In our general account we currently have a balance of \$30,000. The amount we have to spend this year is \$11,000. We will vote on our budget for the year at next month's meeting.

# Gaming Account

- The current gaming account bank balance is \$10,048
- I applied for the current year's gaming grant in April and we have not heard yet if the school will receive a grant this year
- Looking at budget for upcoming year, we have one year remaining to spend
  \$3228 and two years remaining to spend
  \$6820
- There are two budget items totalling \$2000 that will carry forward from last school year (Japanese Garden Refurbishment and North Side Garden Boxes)
- We will vote next month on the gaming account budget


