



777 new books added to the collection

We strive to increase diverse representation, ensuring each student sees themselves within our collection. We are so fortunate to live in a time with such incredible books being written, illustrated and published!

> 12,441 books checked out

3158 books weeded from the collection

Weeding is the process of reevaluating resources in the library collection, and removing items that are worn out, have outdated/inaccurate information or are no longer serving learning needs and reading interests of students at the school. The weeding process is thoughtful and strategic, and a critical part of collection development.



One of our goals is to, not just increase circulation over time, but have the kids actually reading the books they check out! Dynamic shelving, updating the collection and student input are a few ways of achieving this goal!

704 library blocks

Each week, all classes come down to the library for their own individual library block. Here, we chat about their lives, read a book, check out books, tinker, and more!


88 collaboration blocks


