Gaming Account

The current gaming account bank balance is \$9,369

Looking ahead... we have one year remaining to spend \$2689 and two years remaining to spend \$6680

I have applied for the gaming grant for next school year and the PAC has three years to spend the funds if we are successful in receiving a grant this year

General Account

Our bank balance is \$35,755 with the following notes to make...

- Restricted Funds include \$15,500 for playground
- Total fundraising for last school year was \$10,152 (hot lunch, pizza days, movie night, pub social, and bank interest)
- PAC surplus funds is \$20,254 with the budget for the current school year still to be decided
