How to order...


All New Families must register a new account with Munchalunch:

Go to https://munchalunch.com/schools/LordByng

Click the "Register Here" button.

The system will guide you through the process of adding children.

After adding your child(ren) click the "Order Lunch" button to order. Next time, just click the "Login here" button to access your account. It is recommended you sign up to receive a reminder email the day before hot lunch is delivered. Returning families will just need to update their students' grade and division upon first signing in.



The Hot Lunch days are as follows:

EVERY WEDNESDAY: Pizza Factory

Dec 13: Fuel Catering (due Dec 5)

Please note:

For Pizza Wednesdays: Order must be placed and paid in full the Sunday before that Wednesday. For Hot Lunches: Orders must be placed and paid in full 9 days prior to the scheduled lunch date as per our vendor requirements. Unpaid orders will be canceled. Make sure you follow the order all the way to the end to pay! Munchalunch automatically cancels an order that hasn't been paid within 1 hour. Munchalunch charges us a per transaction fee, so if you are able to order and pay for multiple lunches in one transaction you will be saving the PAC transaction fees.

If your child is absent on the lunch date, you are welcome to come and pick up the order by noon, but the food cannot be kept for the following day.

Consistent with previous years, there are **NO REFUNDS**.
