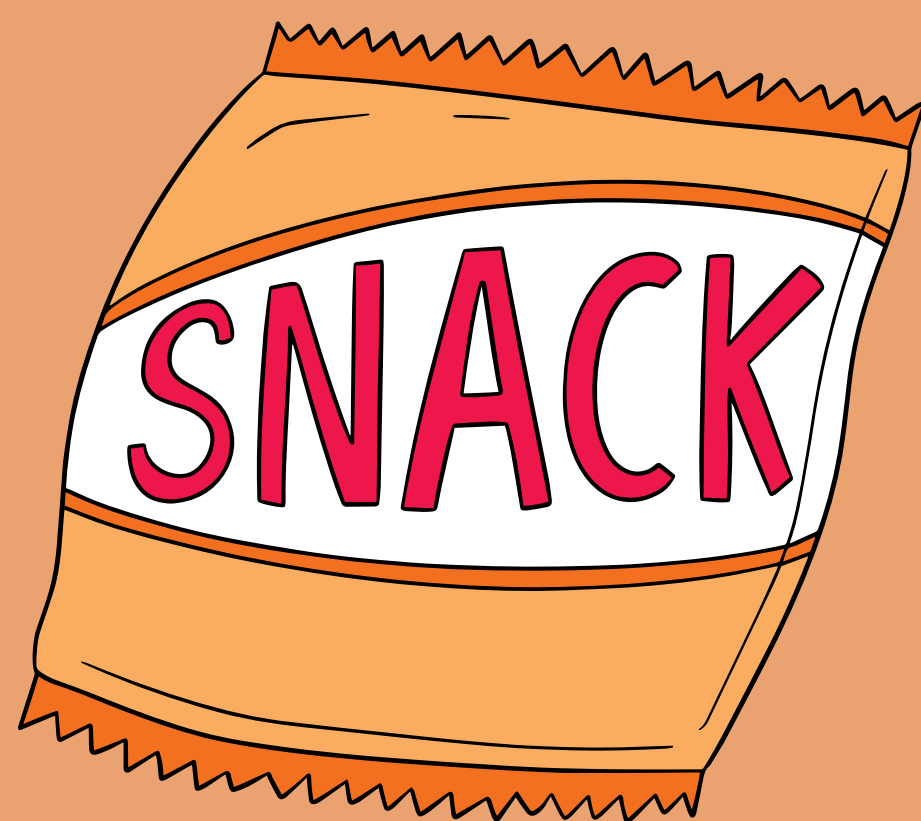

Things to consider if your child feels unwell...

Without proper rest, a child may have a hard time fighting an illness or be at risk for other illnesses. Please keep your child home if they:

Have a fever (Are too sick to take part in all normal school activities).

Have a suspected or known communicable disease (i.e. strep throat, chicken pox, measles).

Is vomiting or has diarrhea. It is recommended that students be symptom free for at least 24 hours before returning to school.

Keep your child home until they are able to participate fully in normal school activities or as directed by a health care provider.

If the school finds it necessary to send your child home because of illness, please make sure you have arranged an emergency contact if you are not available.



Students who carry an Epi Pen and/or Inhaler last year will receive a new form for 2025/2026 sometime next week. Please fill out both sides of the form and attach an original prescription label.

Students who didn't receive a form but need one for this school year can get one from the office. Please contact Ms. Rey, our Vice Principal, if you have any questions.

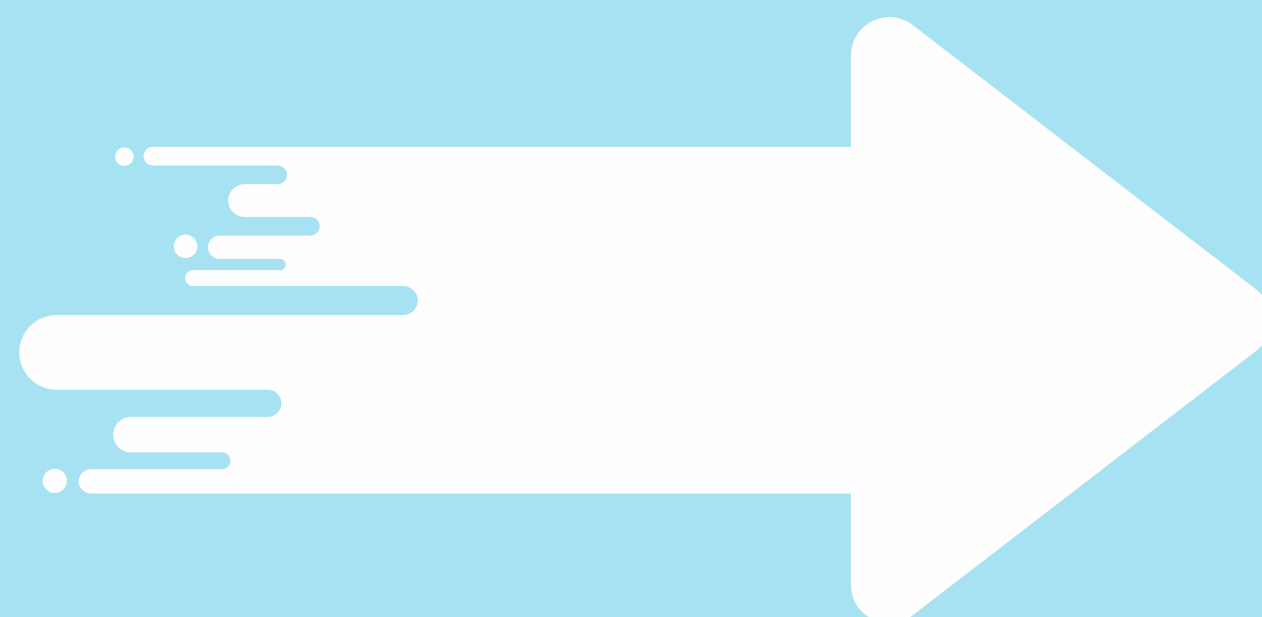
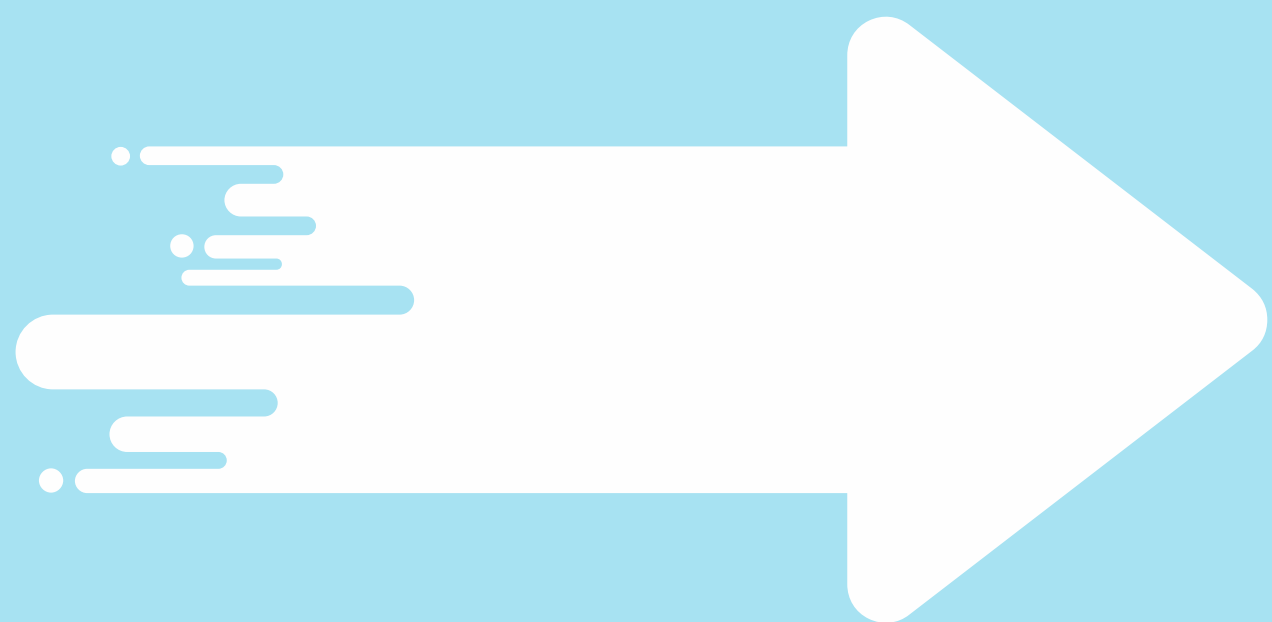
